The basic form of the song is AABA, here is how the entire song lays out.

Intro  
AABA (vocal)  
BA (solo)  
AABA (vocal)

There are 2 main things to watch out for....

1. The intro has 3 pickup notes. You have to play 3 notes before the band starts. Count 1,2,3,4,1 and play on beat 2. The band starts on beat 1 of the next measure, so you're on your own!
2. The solo starts on the B section. After the first vocal (AABA), be ready to start your solo on the B section (F chord). Play just one B section and one A section, and the vocal comes back in at the top of the form. Once the singer comes back in, we're back to the normal AABA form.
